

## OFF-LICENCE

*Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012*

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Big Barrel Enterprises Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **Shop 25, 3 Niagara St, Waitangirua, Porirua**, and known as "**Big Barrel Waitangirua**" to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

### CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Alcohol may only be sold or delivered on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday between 9 am to 10 pm**
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (c) Drinking water must be freely available and displayed whenever alcohol is being supplied by way of complimentary tastings.
- (d) The licensee must always ensure a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued, is displayed inside the premises, so as to be easily read by people using the premises.
- (e) The following relates to damaged goods:
- Where packaging has become broken or damaged (unrecoverable), those items may be repacked and sold in packs of at least four.
  - Premium Beer and Cider products (e.g. premium craft), or products in a vessel measuring 330mls or greater, can be sold as a single unit.
- (f) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
- A restriction of the sale or supply of alcohol to persons under the age of 18 years of age.
  - Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
  - Request evidence of age documents when required.
- (g) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises concerned are observed:
- Alcohol must only be sold and supplied on the premises in accordance with the premises plan submitted with the application received on 14 October 2020.
  - The whole of the premises is to be designated as a 'supervised' area.
  - The holder of a manager's certificate or a properly notified manager shall always be on duty and on the premises when alcohol is sold.
  - The full name of the manager on duty, shall be displayed at all times.
  - A Host Responsibility Policy must be maintained and displayed at all points of sale and the Licensee must ensure all staff receive training in their policy
  - Implement and maintain the Host Responsibility Policy submitted with the application.
- (h) No single sales of Ready to Drink (RTD's)
- (i) The licensee must not offer promotions that encourages people, or is likely to encourage people, to consume alcohol to an excessive extent.

### DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
- until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
- until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
